

## Early Years SLT Training Course 1: Speech and Language Foundation Training

**Overview:** This course provides an essential introduction to speech, language and communication development from birth to five years of age.

**Suitable for:** Practitioners working in Early Years educational settings who have not previously attended training in speech and language development in birth - 5 year olds, or who have not attended this training within the last 2 years. *It is advisable that Early Years Practitioners attend this foundation course before attending any of the other training courses.*

**Key learning outcomes from this course:**

- ★ Know about Speech and Language development milestones from 0-5 years
- ★ Be able to make observations about children's Speech, Language and Communication using the SLT monitoring tool
- ★ Be able to identify children who need further support with their Speech, Language and Communication Needs and learn strategies to support them
- ★ Know how to make a referral to the Early Years SLT Service
