Freedom of Information Act 2000 request: Gift & Hospitality register

With reference to your request for information, dated 27 May 2016, made under section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act, I am writing to inform you of the outcome of your information request.

You asked the following:

'I would like information on your organisation's gifts and hospitality register (or equivalent).

I would like a breakdown in the last five years, items which have been logged on your organisation's gifts and hospitality register by staff, detailing:

Date item was declared

Description of item

Reason for the gift/hospitality

Value

Whether the item was accepted or declined

Additionally, does your organisation have a monetary limit on gifts (ie gifts worth under £50 are allowed) and can cash gifts ever be permitted?'

Our response:

We have broken our response down into three sections.

- 1. The Trust's conflict of interest and code of conduct policy covers gifts and hospitality. The policy is being updated to include recent guidance, following the need for greater NHS transparency via the new "sunshine rule" included in the standard NHS contract from 2016/17. The register is maintained by the Trust Secretary for both Board members and employed staff.*
- 2. Please see the attached PDF file of the current register in relation to the breakdown.*
- 3. Gifts of cash must be refused unless they are donated to charitable funds. The current guidance does not state a monetary value on hospitality of gifts, a sum of £5 for gifts will be included in the new policy.*
