Freedom of Information Act 2000 request: *Sleep Positioning Systems*

With reference to your request for information, dated 23 March, made under section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act, I am writing to inform you of the outcome of your information request.

You asked the following:

The total amount in pounds sterling spent upon “Sleep positioning systems” for the financial year 2014-2015.

The number of requests for funding of “Sleep positioning systems” during the financial year 2014-2015.

The list of diagnoses where funding for “Sleep positioning systems” has been requested during the financial year 2014-2015.

The number of times funding for “Sleep positioning systems” has been requested for the diagnosis of scoliosis in the financial year 2014-2015.

Our response:

Central London Community Healthcare has not funded any sleep position systems for the period stated. The sleep positioning equipment used by our services within the borough of Westminster are funded by social services and there are different arrangements in place for the equipment used in boroughs of Kensington & Chelsea and Hammersmith & Fulham.
