Central London Community Healthcare (CLCH) was formed in 2009 and was awarded NHS Trust status in 2010 we are only able to provide you with information for the last 7 years.


Unfortunately we are unable to provide you with the information requested for Q2 as we believe that the information is exempt from disclosure by way of section 40 of the Act (Personal information). Personal information about living individuals is exempt if disclosure to a third party would breach one or more principles of the Data Protection Act 1998.

Members of Trust staff have an expectation of privacy and would not expect this information to be made available in the public domain, as to do so would be unfair. Therefore, we believe that disclosure of this information would breach the First Data Protection Principle which requires that personal information must be *fairly and lawfully processed*.
